- (4) In case of longer road drive they to give stop over or over night journey breaks as per the case.
- (5) Avoid night night as much as possible.

- (6) Avoid back tracking as much as possible.
- (7) allot minimum 24 hours for each tourist destination in the itinerary. They give sufficient time of visited of popular side sea points.
- (8) Itinerary should not be very lengthy.
