Factor to Considered

- (1) List down the tourist destination in that particular (cluster / sector) State. The places should not be very far of from each other. (2) there should be proper connectivity from one place to the another (by road and by train, by flight / by water ways)
- (3) ~~On~~ All the destination in the itinerary should have basic tourist facilities.
- (4) In case of longer road drive try to give stop over or over night journey breaks as per the case.
- (5) Avoid night night drives as much as possible.

- (6) Avoid back tracking as much as possible.
- (7) allot minimum ^{require} ~~require~~ ^{allow} ~~allow~~ time of each tourist destination in the itinerary. They give sufficient time of visited of popular side sea points.
- (8) Itinerary should not be very lengthy.
- (9) Put the ^{sight seeing} ~~side sea~~ point at each tourist destination in logical sequence.
- (10) They ^{should} ~~should~~ include the "Must" activity of each destination as a part of your ^{itinerary} ~~itinerary~~.
- (11) Suggest ^{optional} ~~optional~~ activities that are possible at each destination.
