Baggage

IATA defined baggage as articles effect and other personal belonging of passenger destined to be used by them.

Comfort and convenience during the journey.

Passenger baggage is transported in two ways

- ① Undecked baggage, which is also known as Cabin baggage & is carried by the passenger & stored in the aircraft cabin itself. This baggage is also known as hand baggage or carry on baggage.

The general accepted dimensions for carry on baggage are:-

- ① Maximum length 56 cm (22 in)
- Maximum width 45 cm (18 in)
- depth 25 cm (10 in)

These dimensions includes wheels, handle & side

(2) Checked Baggage

This is checked & registered at this check in counter & taken away to be stored by airport baggage handlers in the aircraft hold.

Air Craft hold is part of aircraft located in the aircraft under belly.

The air lines responsible for the safe transportation of checked passenger baggage

Free Baggage Allowance

Each passenger is given a specific free baggage allowance when he buys passenger ticket.

Economy - 20k

First / Business - 2 PC

① Sum of all three dimensions

1. Sum of all three dimensions must not exceed 62 inch (158 cm) for the first bag.
- (2) The over all dimension for the two 2 pie measure together must not exceed 107 inch.
- (3) The weight of 2 bag not to be exceed 32 kg.

Pooled Baggage

When two or more passengers are travelling together b/w the same origin & destination points on the same flight, check in together then they are permitted to pool in their baggage i.e. they are permitted to a total free Baggage allowance which is equal to the sum of their individual free baggage allowance.

General Baggage rules are general Baggage guidelines.

(1). The Passenger name, Phone no and Address of both return & destination must appear on the Baggage.
