






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Q.9 The top view and the elevation from X direction of a solid object is given below. Draw the sectional view of the object when cut through AB.






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Q.10 Draw a 3-dimensional object as viewed from X direction from the 2D surfaces given below. The dotted lines indicate folding references to generate the 3D object.


