3. How does Dickens satirize the social and economic conditions of his times through *Hard Times*?

OR

Sparsit is a fairly minor character in Hard Times. What themes does she illustrate? Why is she important in terms of plot development?

4. Discuss Hardy's portrayal of women in *Jude the Obscure*.

OR

Do you see Jude as a Tragic Hero of the Victorian times or a morally corrupt person?
